Exec. Manager - Fundraising at CPS. Before coming to the meeting Jeff researched the history of the CPS-Preston Rotary partnership. It goes back 20 years and to date totals \$228,000.

Elizabeth thanked especially President Geoff and Bernie Lamers. Bernie even was hands on with his organizational skills while his heart was needing/receiving medical support!

NEW ROTARIAN JOAN ROOSE: Introducing Joan, Lenore Thornton spoke of Joan's amazing 'working' life - from 11 years in WestPac Banking to a trip to India to visit a child she was sponsoring. The latter opened her heart and mind. The desperate poverty of the lower castes and the lack of pure water in slum villages needed immediate action.

Returning home led to her founding <u>Jacob's Well</u>. In India today J.W. has 73 bore wells, 3 community centres and literacy/school programmes in 7 villages.

Next week Joan flies out for 5 months overseeing and



organizing. Now as Rotarian. Joan will visit Indian Rotary Clubs and, no doubt, gain their support superb her work.
