YOUTH SERVICES (Report by Chair Chris Shields): Members - Chris Shields, Lenore Thornton, David Sullivan, Ken Kirby, Paul Donovan.

1. Projects for 14/15 - Secondary School Scholarships @ \$1,000 Thornbury, Ruthven, Reservoir; RYLA sponsorship; NYSF sponsorship, School Camp sponsorships (2 schools); Opening the Doors Foundation. Total committed - \$8,975

2. Comments: Met with previous Chair Carla Finocchiaro. Student for NYSF selected and approved by District.



ROTARY FOUNDATION (Report by Chair Peter Peyton): members - Peter Peyton, Peter Gilbert, John McCarthy.

Budget for this Rotary year is \$8000.

Proposals to date;

1. It is planned to donate between \$4000 and \$5000 to the Australian Rotary Foundation Trust, Annual Fund, the Permanent Fund and Polio Plus.

2. We have been approached by the 'Rotary Club of Kandy Metropolitan' in Sri Lanka to assist in the purchase of a much needed Water Purification unit for the Nephrology ward of the Peradiniya Teaching hospital with the help of a Global Grant. Expenditure for this is likely to be between \$1000 and \$2000.

3. November is Foundation month and the committee plans to contact each Club member to ask for a contribution to Rotary Foundation similar to what was done last year.

4. We have the annual visit by our District Governor Patti Bulluss at the end October and her partner Lance has nominated The Rotary Foundation Trust as his special project for this Rotary year. The Foundation committee would like to contribute the money collected from members to Lance on that visit, to put towards his project. Shortly, letters will be sent to all members.

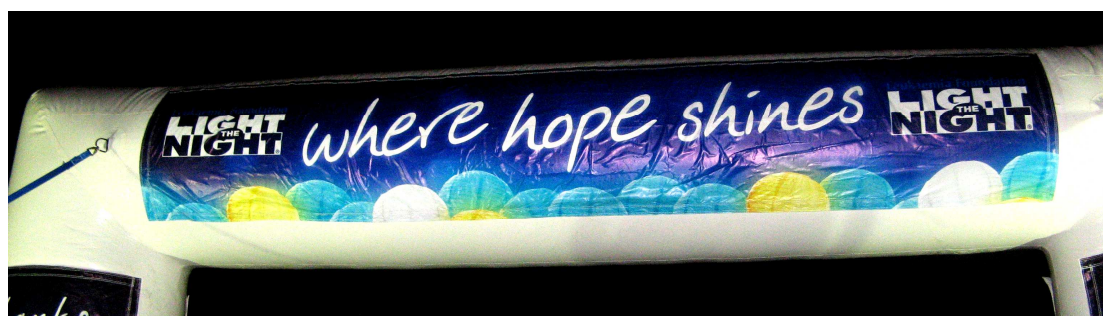

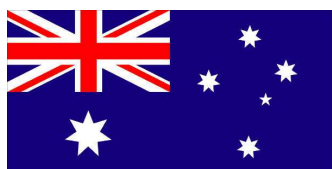
