Originally a youngster from the island nation of Malta, <u>**Paul Lloyd**</u> has spent his working life with Melbourne-based Ford Motor Co.. He is a recent member of the Rotary Club of Southern Mitchell and at the meeting was accompanied by his club president, Rose King. With service his passion, Paul has initiated and spread extensively the <u>**PROJECT LEMUR**</u>.



Started in July 22, the project is designed to support 1,500 Primary School children and their teachers at St. Vincent's Primary School in the small city of Ambovombe, the southern region of Androy, Madagascar. Madagascar is a French speaking nation and twice the size of Victoria.

The poverty-stricken area on the

southern tip of Madagascar has suffered 4 years of successive drought in addition to the Covid-19 pandemic, which is forcing families in rural communities to resort to desperate measures to survive. Their basis food is rice, eaten three times a day. With the Ukrainian war, disaster is current and starvation looms. Donations will be used to source food, clean drinking water, medicines and school equipment. This will help parents unable to keep their children fed and attend school. Paul has connected with the Rotary Club of North Boston which has previously run a project in the area. In a very short time numerous Rotary clubs in the District have joined in with donations while the wider community has been generous. Given that the school has no water, Paul is raising \$20,000 to dig a well for the school.

This is a venturesome service to needy Madagascans and Paul's enthusiasm is an inspiration to witness. Members can imagine the rope being thrown to people grasping for life's thread. Shortly Paul will have a hip replacement and
