REFUNDS is illegal. If



a person has a receipt and the goods purchased are faulty, not

fit for purpose, do not match the description or unsafe, the purchaser has the right to a refund. Always be polite when approaching the desk! At this moment interruptions via questions (4) came from the floor! Robert suggested a photo of receipt on purchase a good move.

In home services he recommended no payment until services are finished and done with due care and skill (always with a receipt).



Spot social media **scams**

Door-to-Door sales are illegal before 9am and after 6pm Mon-Fri. After 5pm Sats and never on Sundays or public holidays. With a **DO NOT**

KNOCK only Government or charity fundraisers can knock.

Phone scams: NEVER answer "YES" as this sound can be recorded and further used ("Am I speaking to Geoff?" or "Can you hear me?") **DO NOT CALL** on a phone line expires after 3 years. Reapply.

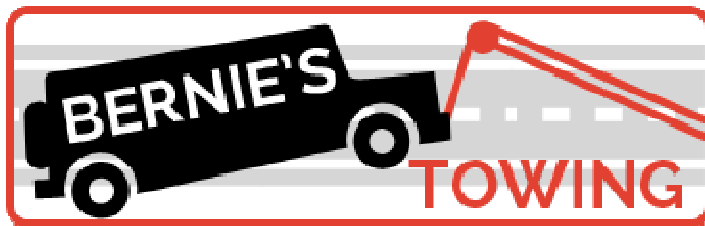
D.G. TONY BRAMLEY writes in his final issue of The Seeds: "The new Orange Sky Laundry van has been ordered".

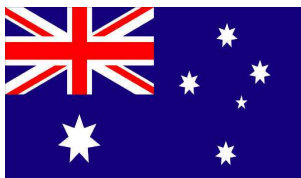
