

Amongst the visitors was **Vici Funnell**, Australia Day Ambassador and Chair of Operation Cleft. In accepting the Club's Major Donation, Vici highlighted the immense value of "mini camps" for surgeons in the countries visited by top Australian surgeons to train them in the latest procedures. An example of the specialist shortage is Bangladesh. With its' population of over 155 million, Bangladesh has only 40 qualified plastic surgeons.

DONATIONS FROM FUNDRAISING EXCEEDS \$2.5 MILLION

The Rotary Club of Preston has celebrated its 55th anniversary. Over the past 55 years the Club and its members have donated to a wide-range of services to support members of the community.


Initially it was the Schizophrenia Fellowship and Wellways retains the same focus -
