RECOGNITION OF VOCATIONAL EXCELLENCE IN OUR COMMUNITY: While the Club has experienced many Vocational themes during this October, last Wednesday's recognition of three students from NMIT's 'Chefs School' in Preston was most meaningful.

Club Members present at the recognition dinner were on location at the NMIT St. Georges Restaurant. Brian McLaine, Caitlan Goodchild and Fiona Hede, the three awardees, attended with their guests. The meals were cooked and presented by NMIT students and the head of the Department of Hospitality and Tourism, **John Hand**, was the speaker while also in attendance was **Mel Riel**, Manager Food and Beverage Operations.

In his few words, John outlined the hard work put in by students in his department. Many are already working full-time or are apprenticed. They sacrifice social time others would spend on themselves and friends. Their hours of work can be exhausting. All this demands experienced guidance from staff. Apprentices need support and advice. Recent cuts in finance to TAAFE Staff has increased strains all round.



Numerous questions followed including one on the disposal of waste, another on capacity (250 enrolled with an optimum of 500) and another on butchery.

The day was complimented by NMIT's own grown and produced

Northern Estates wines. Their Grampians region Shiraz was a winner.

The dinner finished on a surprise. It underlined the Rotary object of Vocation. **Elena Bonnici**, employer of awardee Caitlan, spoke on the value of formal training and mentoring. Elena, of Maltese Italian background, has been in the trade for 20 years with Pizza Meine Liebe in Northcote (just north of Town Hall) and United Arab Eatery (north of Separation St). Elena described the transition from the 70/80 hour week (40 or less hours pay) to present day conditions. Well recognized in her field, she spoke of the relevant vocations/training/skills and devotion to the trade.

TREASURER: (Précis of Report by chair Frank Smith)

Club Maintenance, The income includes Annual dues and interest received on term deposits. For the Club 75% of income is derived from these two items. For year ended June 2014 Club income totaled \$20,717.

Club Expenses for the last Rotary year were \$16,787. The largest expenses are levies paid to Rotary International and Rotary District. In addition the Club makes payments for the monthly Rotary magazine as well as District blanket insurance. These costs were nearly 40% of total club expenses. Other major expenses include Club Bulletin, Club Changeover night, cost of badges, banners etc.

Fundraising Income is mainly derived from Circus Quirkus - last year \$145,000. GST payable and management reduced this to a net \$133,671. Other fundraising included Bollywood Night and Hat Day.

Fundraising payments for last year totaled \$155,118 - Major Donations \$59,335, foundation \$8,000, Community \$18,678, International \$9,787, Special Projects \$46,250, Vocational \$7,500 and Youth \$5,568.

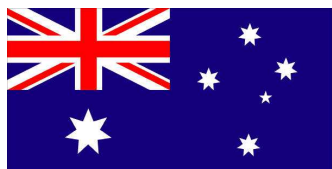
