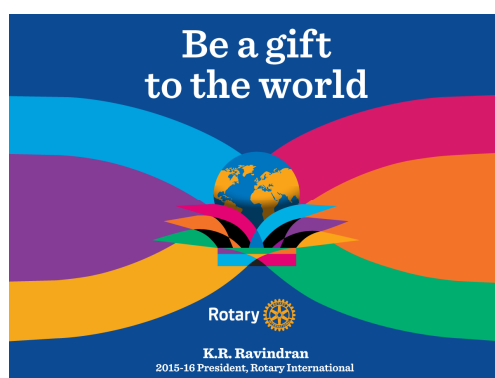

Australia's Gift to the World!

IAN H.S. RISELEY, of the Rotary Club of Sandringham, Victoria, is the selection of the Nominating Committee for President of Rotary International in 2017-18.

"We have the programmes and personnel and others have available resources." says Riseley. "Doing good in the world is everyone's goal. We must learn from the experience of the polio eradication programme to maximize our public awareness exposure for future partnerships."



Riseley is a practicing accountant and principal of Ian Riseley and Co., which specializes in advising local and international businesses, and has a strong interest in international affairs. He received the

AusAID Peacebuilder Award from the Australian government in 2002 in recognition of his work in Timor-Leste. He also received the Order of Australia medal in 2006 for service to the Australian community.

"Governments see Rotary as positive representatives of a civil society," he says. "We should work with them to advocate for peace and conflict resolution, just as we are advocating for polio eradication."

A member since 1978, Riseley has served Rotary as treasurer, director, trustee, RI Board Executive Committee member, task force member, committee member and chair, and district governor.

SPEAKER

MOTOR NEURONE DISEASE: REBECCA LAMONT, a speech pathologist, currently based at Bundoora Extended Care, has been with Northern Health since 2009. Given that home-care is her specific role Rebecca has to be right across the latest treatment for MND. Complex care-needs and, with deterioration and duration over many years, the development of neurological approaches have to be in the hands of those treating their clients.

The aim is to maximize the clients' independence while supporting the carers. BEC provides the specialist help with such matters as speech pathology, occupational therapy and continence guidance. Calvary Health Care Bethlehem is on the south side of the city and BEC now aims to provide a more accessible to those north of the city.

MND is both progressive and terminal with no known remedy. It attacks the brain and spinal neurons causing deterioration of the muscles controlling the abilities to speak, swallow and breathe while the mind remains intact. From this comes the need to bolster independence and social connectedness.

Rebecca outlined the use of the ipads given last year by the Club



to BEC. With the speedy deterioration of vocal ability, in past times writing, flash cards or gesture ruled. Today, with the development of electronic devices the picture has changed. BEC moved into this scene in 2014. The patients' experience and rehab outcome was immediate. An added bonus was the ability to handle more clients in the time allotted. The outcomes for patients were clearly evident. For Preston's gift of ipads Rebecca was most grateful.

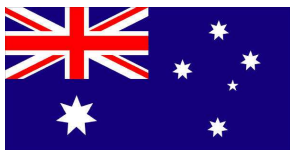
