



The Rotary World President has decided to hold the **2022/2023 ROTARY INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION** in Melbourne - 27 to 31 MAY, 2023.

This would involve between 20,000 and 30,000 Rotarians visiting Melbourne. A variety of hosting strategies are being studied. Examples - a Melbourne club offering a dinner, local Rotarians treating the visitors as house guests, taking groups on trips outside Melbourne, airport movements ....

The Board will look into the club's abilities under the direction of Peter Gilbert. Peter is keen to hear from members. **DICK SMITH – MY ADVENTUROUS LIFE**: In reading Dick Smith's autobiography, David De La Coeur came across an interesting reflection on the establishment of <u>Life Education</u>. For many years Preston Rotary basically



organized the financing etc. of the Melbourne North Eastern branch under the direction of P.P.Carla Finocchiaro.

Life Ed, begun by Ted Noffs in Sydney, saw **Dick Smith** join with valuable assistance especially in finance. Hence its successful establishment and then its Australia-wide development.

David quoted from the book that Life Ed now educates over 700,000 annually.
