SPEAKER LAST WEEK



Dr Margaret Ross is the chief principal investigator and clinical lead for Australia's first psilocybin-assisted psychotherapy study treating depression and anxiety the in terminally ill. Her study is a world first investigating psilocybin-assisted therapy for all palliative conditions. She is a Senior Clinical Psychologist and researcher at St. Vincent's Hospital in Melbourne.

Psilocybin is a naturally occurring psychedelic compound produced by more than 200 species of fungi (mushrooms).

Margaret 's study is very centred:

- + tackling despair and anguish that for some patients facing imminent death leaves them unable to connect with family, friends, memory, self
- + replacing other medications at times unsuccessful and
- + also replacing talking therapy.

In recent times, many psychedelic drugs have been trialled but most are necessarily repetitive and also require added counselling often with little success. For Margaret, the introduction of psilocybin, a mushroom product used by tribal groups over past centuries, has brought about great hopes. After just one dose, studies have shown death anxiety declined. The benefits were sustained for at least six months. The patients were no longer defined by their illness and were able to communicate freely with life outside themselves.

Margaret's research could be dangerous and all aspects of a clinical trial have to be deeply monitored. Clinical research is carried out overseas and the positives have enticed Margaret to study future trials in Australia.
