It was in closing her talk that Victoria Sarah El-Hage stated that the U.N. tries its best to provide answers plays and ۵ pivotal role in and peace She security. referred to the



Italian P.M. Renzi who told her conference attendees "without the role of the younger generation, the pursuit of human rights, security and prosperity is impossible". Victoria added "This young generation believes in <u>trust</u> and <u>connectivity</u> as prerequisites for politics".

Victoria is in her final 2 months of study at LaTrobe for a Bachelor of Laws with Honours and a Bachelor of International Relations. Her research is focused on The Special Tribunal for Lebanon, a U.N. sponsored inquest into the killings in Lebanon of political, cultural and media personalities including the Prime Minister Rafiq Hariri.

The major problem is that the U.N. founding resolution only obliges the co-operation of Lebanon and not the states housing the named culprits. Victoria is analyzing this co-operation regime or, more precisely, its lack. Over 2,000 university students from 115 countries met for the conference in Rome. Victoria approached the Club for assistance to attend as her search for sponsorship uncovered Rotary's prominent service on the international scene.


