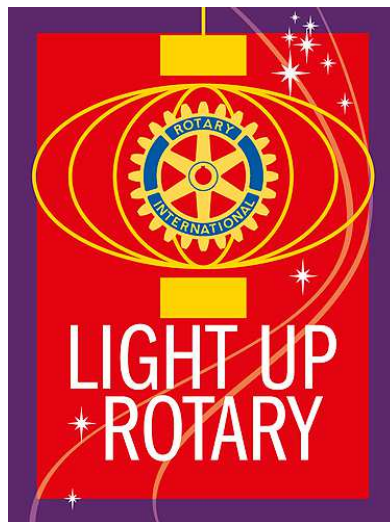

## *SPEAKER LAST WEEK*

**INNER NORTH COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (INCF):** A long title but one much used in the communities of Darebin, Moreland and Yarra. A board member from the early days in 2008, ex mayor of Northcote David Redfearn OAM was well equipped to give a rundown on the Foundation's aims and activities during an evening dinner at NMIT.

While somewhat handicapped by the acoustics and the failure of the overhead, members and guests at the dinner enjoyed tasty suggestions from the St. Georges menu such as Mustard crusted Chicken breast with white bean puree and hot slaw, followed by Sweet corn Bavarois with Viennese short bread and caramel popcorn dust.



More importantly David's talk once again underlined the aim of INCF. A philanthropic grant-making and community-funded foundation, its aim is to improve social outcomes for local people in Melbourne's inner north. The focus is mainly on the younger generation though not exclusively. Currently their programming is titled Programmes to Employment.

INCF gives grants to charitable organizations that assist local residents to develop skills that will increase their employment prospects. Maybe a overly broad statement? No. David described the field of unemployment varying from unmotivated early school leavers to ex-prostitutes seeking more settled opportunities.

Examples of the fundings in 12/13 included:

Employment Pathways for young asylum seekers (Brotherhood of St. Laurence),

Indigenous Leadership Programme (Brotherhood . . . ),

English skills for the Workplace (Carringbush Adult education),  
Youth Pre-Employment Programmes,  
Community Gardens and Marketing.

David's was a positive presentation outlining INCF's positive aims and positive outcomes. He is happy to discuss both the availability of grants and the search for donors.
