CLUB ASSEMBLY

PRESIDENT Paul Smarrelli valued the meeting as being a key part of achieving the Club's Strategic Plan. He gave a summation of this year's first quarter. Paul rated all Goals and Objectives as progressing according to plan. Public Relations will soon be strengthened with Kanan Subramanian uploading the website and creating a Facebook page for the Club.



With membership as the major focus this Rotary year, success in this field spreads the workload of committees across a larger number of Rotarians so as to reach out more widely in the community.

Cumulative attendance to August is 74%, target being 80%. Many Rotarians are wisely spending the winter months travelling.

Paul gave a summary of proposed donations for 15/16. Projects are discussed through structured Committee and Sub-Committee forums. Four Club Forums have been set for the current Rotary year.

TREASURER Paul Smith gave a brief report which included mention of a cheque for \$110,000 from Wayne O'Neill and that he has receipted 27 members for this year's annual fee.

IT/WEBSITE: Kanan Subramanian reported on the current status of the Club web page (cf. below) and the value in subscribing to Facebook. The web page will be updated twice weekly.

YOUTH: Elaine Price listed the support for one student to RYLAH and a second to the Canberra Science Forum. The committee is also involved in the Darebin Council Youth Leadership planning.

VOCATIONAL: Les Woodland reminded members of the St Georges dinner with two awards (cf. *Looking Forward*). David Warry spoke of the

Kew-based stroke recovery programme and the search for employment of a Thomastown stroke victim.

INTERNATIONAL: Peter Byrne submitted a fulsome report on its doings. The Burnet Institute figured with speaker Dr Jack Richards, the request for funding for "New diagnostics for lymphatic filariasis for Timor-Leste" and assistance given to Medecins Sans Frontieres, Care Australia and Shelterbox. The urgent message from Dr Richards featured below in Notes and News arrived shortly after the meeting!

Alex is currently in Timor funded by the money that you gave for testing for sexually transmitted infections. This is the first such testing in Timor-Leste! We have the first actual positive tests today.

Without giving any confidential information away, a mother just gave birth to a baby. The mother had a genital discharge and the baby developed a severe conjunctivitis eye infection. We were able to diagnose them both with gonorrhea and they are now receiving treatment which will be curative. This is thanks to Preston Rotary. I am so pleased at this achievement. Please pass this on to your members and give them my deepest thanks. We are making a difference and improving lives!"
