

#### SPEAKERS LAST WEEK

NATIONAL YOUTH SCIENCE FORUM: It is now 30 years since the National Science Summer School Inc. began operations with Rotary in Australia as its founding partner. Now known as National Youth Science Forum, it helps students moving into Year 12, who wish to follow careers in science, engineering and technology. This is done largely by introducing them to research and researchers, by encouraging the achievement of excellence in all their undertakings, and by helping to develop their communication and interpersonal skills. It also fosters discussion of, and interest in, major national and global issues and emphasizes the importance of maintaining continuing active interests in sport, arts and

achievement. Australia-wide 1400 students applied from which 400 were accepted.

The Forum is run by Staffies (ex-attendees) and each participator was matched up with a 'buddy'. Then the students were divided into interest groups. This determined the talks/locations/programmes for the parties.

During the Forum they visited and witnessed research laboratories and experiments, medical and science institutes, particle accelerators and the Australian National University. The 4 days were opened with talks by Professor Bruno Van Swinderen who works in the drosophilia cognitive neuroscience field and Andrea Morello whose interest is quantum spin control.

What Erica and Steve had for their breakfasts was difficult to ascertain but their time in Canberra was informative, educational and socially enjoyable. In fact, to be selected was its own achievement.
