SPEAKER LAST WEEK

MATT GLOVER'S life had many transitions prior to his setting up of MGA COUNSELLING SERVICES. To mention a few of his past occupations: chemistry training and working with Dulux Paints; full time ministry in the Baptist Church; specialised Pastoral Care in diverse fields; a Masters in Counselling.



Now Matt is involved with many overseeing committees assisting other counsellors, psychologists, spiritual carers, social workers. A main direction of his work is training specialists in LGBTIQ issues and culture – the field of his recent address.

While himself not being gay, Matt found his initial involvement with the gay community after many years of observing the systematic, exclusionist, down-grading treatment given persons openly professing their gay characters. He gave examples which were most atrocious and yet quite believable. While working in the Baptist ministry his aim was to make everyone welcome.



However, it was too early for the leadership at that time, mainly in dealings with members of the LGBTIQ community. Stories of exclusion he heard tell were *'horrifying and would break one's heart'*. He summed up the enforced homelessness, mental traumas and health issues resulting as *"the suffering of those not permitted to live their lives as themselves"*.

All of the above has led him to his establishing MGC where a high percentage of his clients are from the LGBTIQ community. Before closing, Matt had advice for Rotarians and their clubs. Matt outlined as with his own practice,

Rotarians have a part to play – *“to welcome people for who they are and let people know they are welcome. Encourage them to be themselves . . . to live as they see themselves”*.


Thanks to those who remembered the cane basket collection for Christmas at Rimern. The basket will be there weekly for whenever a member remembers through to December – great.
