SPEAKER LAST WEEK

Are you pumping too much iron?

A Preston native, <u>Karin Calford</u> came up from Launceston for the meeting and brought with her a wealth of knowledge in the field of <u>HAEMOCHROMATOSIS</u>. From the Committee of Haemachromatosis Australia (HA), Karin's was a message of AWARENESS for G.P.s, their patients and the general public. In short, what you don't know can hurt you and can have fatal results.

<u>Finance</u>: With no government funding, HA is run by a committee of 8 volunteers. All funding comes from membership fees and private and

corporate donations.

Why do we do what we do? Because there is so much unawareness of the disease which is both treatable and manageable.

Unfortunately there are so many stories of late diagnoses, HA sees the urgent need to get the news broadcast. Karin gave a few very sad stories of late diagnoses.



What do we do? Karin spoke of the patient resources HA offers - print, phone-line, CD and video. Rotarian Elaine stars in an explanatory 10 minute on-line video - youtube Haemochromatosis explained. An annual H. Awareness Week (Aug 7-13) also highlights the disease.

<u>H = Iron Overload</u>. Because of an errant gene the body is storing up iron and, untreated, kills off those organs. The treatment is by blood donation; the iron goes out with the blood and the health of the body returns to normal. A patient with H will become a lifetime blood donor and that blood is usable country wide. H sufferers give more than 4% of the total donated Australia wide. The iron overload does not become evident till around early middle-age.

<u>Professional awareness.</u> Only 2 simple blood tests are required. Easy to request however the nature of early symptoms are so everyday and given the 'rare' prevalence of H', red lights don't flash the possibility of H. Hence Karin's opening statement stressing the universal need for professional and patient awareness.
