

LIYA DJAMBATJ BANUMBIRR is the name of the Programme devised for the Aboriginal students from the remote communities when they come in to board at the <u>Nhulunbuy High</u> <u>School.</u>

At the beginning of this year, a 40 bed boarding complex was built beside the public high school in the remote mining town at Nhulunbuy, N.T. "Nhulunbuy High School and boarding school has given me the opportunity to attend a major school and still be close to my family and my land," the 17-year-old told the crowd that had gathered for the official opening.

The programme aims to assist the students to develop skills which will prepare them for future employment, such as marine studies, relevant trades or ranger work. All the appropriate workplaces require the students to be wearing steel-capped boots.

The following is their Mission/Vision Statement:

VISION: To facilitate achievement for local Aboriginal students so that they can successfully navigate the contemporary world whilst maintaining a strong sense of Aboriginal culture, language and tradition.

MISSION: To provide a family-like context for learning that is both culturally appropriate and responsive. To teach the mainstream curriculum in a way that builds upon the foundational knowledge of Aboriginal culture, language and tradition.

Liya Djambatj will provide opportunities for local Aboriginal students to transition successfully to level-appropriate classes. Students will understand and have access to pathways to work or further study within their local community or beyond.

IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST FROM NHULUNBUY

<u>Peter Byrne reports:</u> "On behalf of the Club, I've just sent a dozen pairs of safety boots plus socks to the brand new boarding school. Up to now, the students haven't been able to go on work experience to local businesses because they haven't had safety boots. Now they will be able to. This will give them much wider opportunities for work when they leave school".
