

SPEAKER LAST WEEK

MUSKAAN SUPPORT AUSTRALIA: A constant question faces Rotary: "Are we bridging the gap between the rich and the poor"? Wednesday's speaker, Marion Hadingham, addressed the question with a solid practical outline of the Muskaan Support Australia (MSA).

In 2008-09 Marion was a volunteer teacher at Muskaan while her husband Kevin was working on a project with the Public Works Department of Madhya Pradesh in Bhopal.

Marion is an experienced teacher across primary education, special education and adolescent health and welfare. She was very impressed by the focus of Muskaan on achieving positive education outcomes for disadvantaged children from the slums through the development of relevant curriculum reflecting the realities of life experiences in the slums and delivered using engaging, child-centred teaching methods.

Since inception, Muskaan has a proven track record at all levels. It



has over 3,000 students. Over the past 3 years, 62 children have appeared for Board examinations and the numbers are growing each year. Several students have progressed to vocational training courses and successfully entered the skilled workforce. Six students are now studying bachelor degrees at colleges.

Marion returned to Australia with a passion to mobilize support for the wonderful work of Muskaan, making a difference in the lives of these children, their families and their communities.

Muskaan Support Australia Inc. has been established by Marion and Kevin, together with others sharing the vision, to raise Australian support for Muskaan's programs and the building of a dedicated campus in Bhopal.

The Rotary Club of Eltham is organizing a Volunteers Trip to Muskaan in November 2014. The aim is to witness first-hand its work and to provide input from the trip participants' diverse skills during the 2 week visit; skills such as education, health, music, arts/crafts, computers. MSA is a project of the Rotary Club of Eltham, Victoria, Australia in partnership with Muskaan and the Rotary Club of Bhopal (Midtown)

NOTES AND NEWS

<u>HELP NEEDED</u>: We currently have 2 ROMAC Children in Melbourne for treatment and I have 4 more children who we will bring for surgery in Melbourne soon.

The first of these, **Bradley Bola**, had scull surgery in 2009 at Royal Children's Hospital. Bradley is now 17 years old and needs another operation on his scull to realign his face, which will be done at Epworth Hospital in Richmond. Bradley arrives on the 25th August and I have yet to find Rotarians to care for him and his mother, before and after surgery. They will probably be in Melbourne for about 5 weeks and we need a home for them.

During the first couple of weeks we need homes in Melbourne to be close to the hospital, but during the recuperation phase it is often possible for children to stay in the country. We also require a list of volunteers who can help hosts out with driving, visiting and outings.
