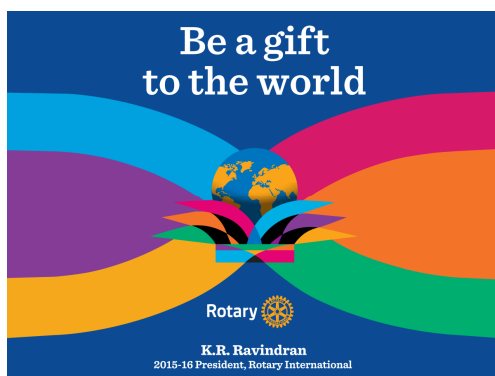

THE PAVILION SCHOOL: While this was a brief two hour lunch-time visit, the total of intricacies, facets and divisions outlined was overwhelming. The overall conclusion was one of hope and success.

The energetic and switched on guides were Michael Scicluna (Classroom Teacher/Site Manager) and Andrew Zarafa (Pathways and Transitions Cousellor / Student Wellbeing). The ethic of the school is well known to Rotarians having been addressed in earlier times by Nick Orchard (Beacon Foundation) and Andrew.

The 17 members visiting last Wednesday gained more colorful and hands-on comprehension of the school's practice. Portrayed on one wall was the slogan "*He who opens a school door closes a prison*". Michael took the members through the roll call. While a certain percentage had a crime background others had problems of acceptance at other schools because of bullying, motherhood, disabilities or "unteachableness".

Two students spoke of the warm open-door environment. The welcoming and accepting spirit of the staff was a major key in the school's success. Members left with a clearer picture of "*what can be done*".

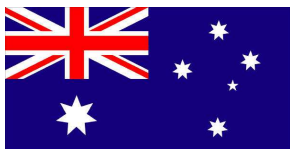
