RECENT SPEAKER

GETTING RID OF OLD BAGGAGE: John Cirak, a onetime

Townsville Rotarian is the CEO of Coaching Group. ReGENESIS coaching ReGENESIS practice is a programs specializing in that help people transition into a new life, particularly after separation and from divorce long α term relationship. John admits to a number of failed relationships and a profound learning trail to his present happy place in life. The trail demanded he deal with life/the world in a whole new different way and not to be continually digging into his old baggage.

For John, the biggest demand made on him was to rid himself of his old baggage. He discovered within himself



the capacity and the power to change. He overcame that which pained him and he developed new relationships and created a richer, more meaningful life.

These is the principle on which is based his "Get Rid of Old Baggage and Create New Luggage" coaching programmes; programmes based on coaching sessions that can lead to new relationships and a richer and happier while reflecting a more truthful life.



To illustrate his point John described his move from the treacherous slide from the top of the world to the bottom. Then surfaced his need to have another look at himself/his baggage. After two divorces, cancer, bankruptcy and kidney

troubles, he discovered his unresolved emotional baggage he had packed away many years past. The unpacking began! He stopped blaming others, judging others and started afresh.

Then followed the discovery of new fresh baggage - love, health, consideration of others (*less about me*), toleration, curiosity (*and growth*), vision, mission and motivating goals.

John's harrowingly honest 'message' was relevant for all present and a great stimulus for the Club as it moves into a New Year.
