

ROTARIAN BEHIND THE BADGE: <u>Kapil</u> <u>Argarwal</u> gave members present an inside not only into his life so far, but also a short historical tour of his Indian home town of Gwalior. Like Melbourne, Gwalior is a city with a rich cultural tradition, great dynasties, poets, musicians and saints.

Born into a family involved in finance, finance was to be his professional path. He started his own business in India. he moves in and, in most cases, is able to succeed often times with the same bank. This leaves him with a sense of satisfaction in helping people.

Kapil and **Anju** have three children, one studying in India and two youngsters here. Many questions followed, mostly in the finance field. Kapil is proud that he seems never to have had a dissatisfied customer.
