

SPEAKER LAST WEEK

BURNETT INSTITUTE UPDATE: <u>Jack Richards</u> is a Black Rock lad and now a leader at the highly reputed Institute with intense research into Malaria. At a visit last year some Club members met Jack at the Institute. The Club has supported the Institute with its recent work in



Timor Leste. Last week Jack visited the Club to meet with Members, to recognise its support and to speak on present cutting edge research.

Jack gave a very precise description of malaria – its causes, specific diagnoses, inbody effects, treatment and its future. An amateurish description would say it is a parasitic infection passed on by mosquitoes. It enters the body and travels to the liver where it replicates itself up to 30,000 times. It is then passed on to the blood cells and the rest is history.

It was the experience of 1 year of

medical service in Kenya in 2000 that directed Jack to his present research into malaria. 2/3 of Kenyan school children have livers infected with the parasite. Malaria's common ground of attack is children under 3 and pregnant women.

Bill and Melinda Gates have come on board in the plan to eradicate and eliminate malaria. Whenever success seemed at the doorstep malaria has respread rapidly. Sadly this seems the case at present. Medication is always changing rapidly and Jack sees progress though many medications

are superficial. Burnett Institute has been working with Vietnam and Cambodia though political complications have made Cambodia a no-go zone. 2 border provinces in Vietnam, zones of poverty and unemployment, are centres of activity and Preston's finance is



helping in that development. Rapid diagnostic tests, local training and mosquito elimination, these are some of the current approaches. This is a whole world involvement and Jack is thankful for Preston's part.

induction into Rotary last Wednesday. Nick's grandfather is an active Rotarian in Naracoorte while Nick is a holder of the Rotary Young Achievers Award. He has worked tirelessly with those of the younger generation 'at risk' and in particular indigenous youth.

Currently he is also playing an active role with the Pavilion School. Nick brings with him great expectations to the life of Preston Rotary.

CHILDREN FIRST GALA NIGHT: It's on Saturday, October 10 and PP Peter Gilbert is interested in setting up a Preston table.


<u>malaria (n.)</u>

1740, from Italian *mal'aria*, from *mala aria*, literally "bad air," from *mala* "bad" (fem. of *malo*, from Latin *malus*; see <u>mal-</u>) + aria "air". Probably first used by Italian physician Francisco Torti (1658-1741). The disease, now known to be mosquito-borne, once was thought to be caused by foul air in marshy districts. Replaced native <u>ague</u>.
