That day Elaine received an email stating that a new video-conferencing facility have been named after Les. The communication ran:



Les joined Ford at Queensland, Australia in 1953. He spent almost 60 years working at Ford, predominantly in Accounting and Treasury. Les was a perfectionist who worked with great humility and understanding. He was admired for his knowledge of Ford's systems and Finance Manuals.
