

SPEAKERS LAST WEEK

While <u>KAREN WALKER</u> works as a clinical psychologist with the **Australian Community Support Organization**, her glowing interest is mental health in the third world centering on the African Continent.

After a trip through many countries with her daughter she fueled the desire to return to Africa and contribute there. Following a climb of Kilimanjaro, Tanzania captured her attention. Two determining factors were the beauty of the people and the tragedy of the non-existent mental health services for the young. Arusha in Northern Tanzania is the place Karen knows and it is there she is aiming to contribute what she can.

90% of children in developing countries who suffer a mental

disability do not have access to mental health services. Evidence based knowledge in Western countries affirms treatability of common varied mental and disorders. In developing countries these treatments are nonexistent. Non-treatment results is a permanently disabling identity.



Given the lack of education in those countries, those with a mental illness are discriminated against. They are seen as crazy. It's a lose-lose situation and, for them participation is society is zero.

Karen's solution included: persons educated to specialize in the field, working with the locals in a culturally sensitive and helpful line with the community, training within the local universities, establishing a local office and teaching health workers to recognize and follow up.

VOCATIONAL SHORT PRESENTATION: PP PETER BYRNE was the season's second presenter. With perfect timing and following tightly the guidelines, Peters three steps included:



- * <u>Vocation?</u> Basically a metallurgist. Over his time he has found himself in 5-6 different aspects of metallurgy from the mining to the present day adaptations of metal. Currently Peter sees his vocation as a 'simulated patient' in which role he acts out a medical patient for medical students to diagnose, prescribe and practice their learned medical skills. Recently he was a stroke patient.
- * <u>Mentorship</u>? Yes there were mentors along the way though Peter admits to a certain non-conformity with

their ideas/suggestions.

* <u>Professional vocation and Rotary?</u> Early days was the making of pipes and later occupational health and safety. In that time he did study in managerial competence. Peter saw this as an indirect aid in his recent Rotarian presidency. This was where he learned the need to work through people and not take on the whole load.
