

SPEAKER LAST WEEK

CAREER-CHANGE STRATEGIES: Colin Rochford came with a wealth

of career counseling. His subject was most relevant in these times of career variations.

What happens to people who are retired, made redundant or forced out of work by illness. Career for most people is related with identity. Loss of career is often equated to loss of identity. Loss of identity grows into a life of 'Who cares!' Hence worthlessness, futility and loss of direction. Wow! Enter on stage Colin.



Colin suggested a strategy of three paths to help change that deadness:

- 1. Look at <u>patterns</u> in lives. Patterns which happen while living normal lives. Everyone has had a pattern Identifiable in every stage of life. After reflection, write it down.
- 2. <u>6 Core needs</u>. Things that must happen in lives. Certainty; variety/adventure/uncertainty; significance; belonging; contribution; growth. Write down the top three core needs not being met.
- 3. <u>The wheel of life</u>. This is a diagrammatic series of levels covering the factors - adventure, family, finance, hobbies and interests, friendship, carer, health and fitness, intimate partner. Write down which one ranks lowest.

From these observations three goals should eventuate, one from each path. They must be reasonable and timely. They must meet the needs from the Wheel of Life. They need addressing immediately.

How will one be in 6 months or 2 years if one follows Colin's plans? In concluding Colin offered those present a voucher for two free one hour sessions to redesign habits, create unwavering passion and unlock personal power.
