

LINKS BETWEEN PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH was a captivating subject for last Wednesday's forum at the Preston Town Hall venue. Chaired by President Elaine Price and run in unison with Australian Rotary Health and Mental Illness Fellowship, the forum featured three main speakers. It also enabled <u>Mayor Gaetano Greco</u> tell of Darebin's related input while PDG Terry Grant expanded on the work of Australian Rotary Health.

Associate Professor Felice Jacka of Deakin and Melbourne Universities held everyone silent as she linked the effects of good and bad diet with the mental health of persons of all ages. She spoke of bad diet and the yet to be born baby, pre and early school children, adults and seniors. Mentioning the prevention of depression by a good diet, similar to the effects of smoking and early death. Her last observation was that advocacy for the practice of good diet must come from those present.

<u>Eve Telianidis</u> told her story as sole carer to her son who suffered schizophrenia. It was a saga of trying to survive while simultaneously living a strenuous learning curve. It all ended well with her son now in supervised accommodation with an excellent case manager. Eve is putting her life back on track. Her final message was listen, watch out for others and share your story.



Mark Jackson told of his own saga of from falling business heights to depths the of mental illness and his eventual rebirth to stability fullness and of life.

This was a most successful night with a hall well set

up by Geoff McIlvenna and Paul Josephson and a goodly number of club members present.
