



SPEAKER LAST WEEK

YOUTH SERVICES IN THE CITY OF DAREBIN: <u>Clinton Fullgrabe</u> has the office and the task of co-coordinating these services for local youth ranging from 12 to 25. This is no small role given that, in Darebin,

the youth estimate is around 23-25,000 while his department numbers 8 staff. The department roles range as follows:

- support (those in crisis with an opportunity to reconnect);
- 2. relationship with partnering agencies through referrals
- 3. advisories ("being there for them and giving a them role")
- 4. advocacy (insure that the young are being heard)
- 5. informing(not telling them what to do but helping them in their life forming skills.



The above sum up the mission - for young people to be valued citizens and to aid them in growing to their full potential in whatever capacity. All this is achieved through service delivery, resource allocation and local level planning.

Clinton's service is achieved through 4 areas: recreation and the arts (connectedness), training and education (positive life-style choices), health education and, finally, information and support. The final item has two well attended locations - youth centres at Northland Shopping Centre and at the recently renovated Reservoir Library and Community Centre in Edwards Street. Then there are the multiple public location outreach areas within Darebin.

There are numerous calls on staff to tutor youths in the justice area. This area needs expansion particularly reaching the youth prior to antisocial behaviors and entry into crime. Programmes are expanding in an effort to meet ever growing needs.

Questions brought out information on self-harming, suicide, negative



influence from the internet, out-of-hours involvement, Austin's Camp Crisis etc..... The field is both extensive and real. Clinton's insights were most encouraging.

In recent years Aussie Rotarians have been able to follow closely the growth of a programme started by young α northern **NSW** lady, Gemma Sisia. In 2002. with just 3 students and \$10, Gemma 'opened' a free school in Arusha. Tanzania



This year the school's first graduates enter a year of free 'give-back' tutoring and community service before venturing on their tertiary lives. Gemma's principle is akin to that of Malala Yousafzai, "every child has the right to education - the strongest weapon in the fight against poverty, corruption and political instability". The school now has over 2.000 students, three campuses and 22 buses. High quality education in poverty-stricken Tanzania is rare, but with people as Gemma and backed by Rotary, it is happening.
