

SPEAKER LAST WEEK



Initially, <u>VICTORIA ELHAGE</u> had some of her audience thinking her attendance at the Roman U.N. Conference would see her in deep discussion with Secretary General Ban Ki-moon. No. Victoria's was a Harvard University simulation.

Harvard WorldMun goes back to 1927 with the title of Harvard Model League of Nations Conference. With its

name updated, the annual meet this year will be in Rome, March 14-18, and Victoria will be there. More than 3,000 'delegates', all world-wide university students, will experience the challenges of negotiation by assuming the roles of UN representatives and members of other international decision-making bodies. To gain selection to attend the Conference is extremely difficult. Membership is only for the most prestigious applicants.

Victoria uses the word 'simulation'. It is employing the principles of experiential learning to teach delegates not only how to debate and approach issues in international relations, but also such essential skills as public speaking, diplomacy, cooperation, negotiation and compromise. At the Conference they will deal with such complex global issues as international peace and security and economic and social progress.
