Julie brought a number of important items with her which would all help her explain the special times in her life and what influenced her along her journey.

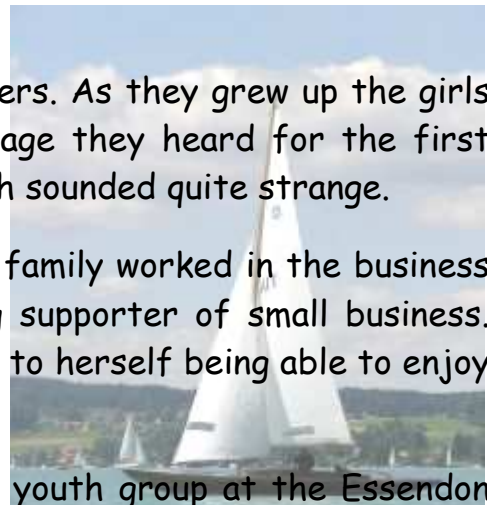

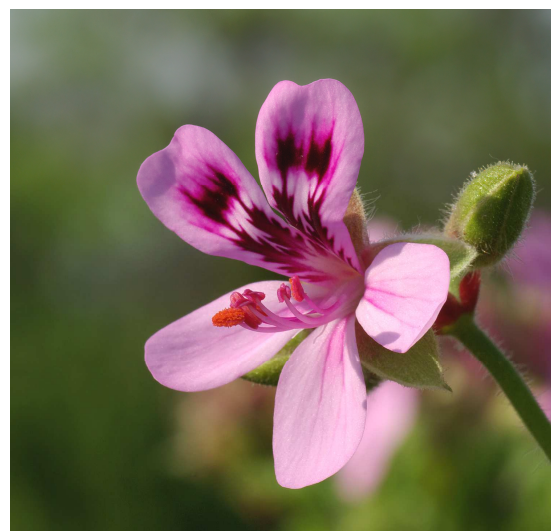

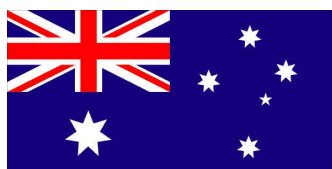
